Glass Preparations Before It Can Be Recycled:

We only accept glass that contained food or beverage.

- Please rinse your glass thoroughly.
- Remove all caps and lids. The steel lids can be recycled with the tin cans.
- Throw away the plastic lids.
- Labels do not have to be removed.
- Sort according to color and try not to break the glass.



How to Dispose of Broken Glass

1. Break the glass with caution.
2. Take proper precautions.
3. Place the bigger pieces in a large trash bag.
4. Vacuum up smaller pieces.
5. Blot the area with a soft piece of bread.
6. Wipe down the area with a damp paper towel.
7. Place the trash bag in a cardboard box.
8. Put the container out with the normal trash.
