This is a completely confidential program. No personal information will be collected. Please remove all prescription labels before arriving.

Here's what you **CAN** bring:

- Prescription medicines of any kind
- Over-the-counter medications
- Medication samples
- Pet medications
- Vitamins, Inhalers
- Medicated ointments and lotions
- Liquid medications leak-proof containers

Here's what you **CANNOT** bring:

- Needles, syringes, lancets
- Thermometers, Aerosol cans
- IV bags, Hydrogen peroxide
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Empty containers
- Personal products (non-medicated shampoo, etc.)
